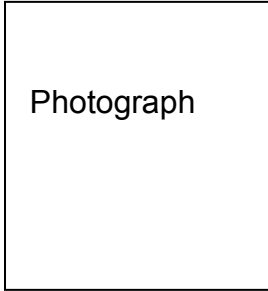

## **Notes to the Applicant:**

### **1) Eligibility Criteria**

#### **Academic requirements:**

Applicants should hold (or be about to obtain) a first or upper second class honours degree, or the overseas equivalent.

Students whose first language is not English required IELTS 7.0 with 7.0 in writing or TOEFL 600 paper-based or 250 computer-based, with 4.5 in Test of Written English

### Other eligibility criteria:

- Hold a 1<sup>st</sup> class or upper second class degree
- Have studied for either an undergraduate or postgraduate degree at a public university only. If a candidate has studied at a private university, evidence must be provided of having secured a scholarship to attend the private university
- Have achieved the minimum English language level for the course
- Not have studied in a developed country for one year or more previously
- Be nationals of a developing Commonwealth country (see Nationality restrictions)
- Be permanently domiciled in a developing Commonwealth country (see Nationality restrictions)
- Not be employed by a National Government or parastatal organisation (universities are exempt from this)
- Be unable to pay for study in the UK
- Return to their home country on completion of award
- Be aged below 35 years at the time of application
